

## Borrowing an eBook for Your Kindle Device or Kindle App From Your Public Library

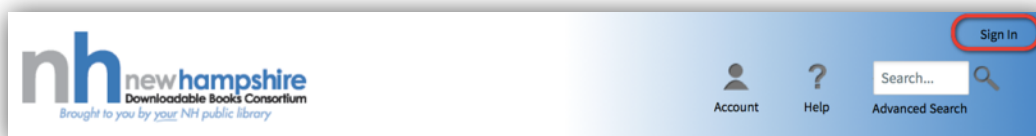

*Most, but not all, of the eBooks found in the New Hampshire Downloadable Books service are compatible with Kindles.*

- If you are using a **Kindle device**, follow these instructions on a computer and send the Kindle Book wirelessly to the device.
- If you are using a **Kindle Fire**, you may follow these instructions on computer or use the Kindle Fire's web browser to send the book wireless to the device.
- If you are using a **tablet device**, you may follow these instructions on a computer or the device's browser.
- If you are using an **iPhone** or an **Android phone**, you may follow these instructions on a computer or on the device's web browser. The site is optimized for smaller screens.

### Log into the site and browse the collection

Log into the site with a library card from a participating New Hampshire public library.

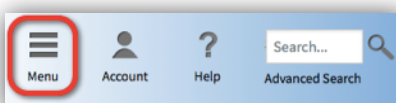


Type in the name of your library or town. Note that some libraries require a prefix or PIN in addition to your library card number. Check with your local librarian for more information.

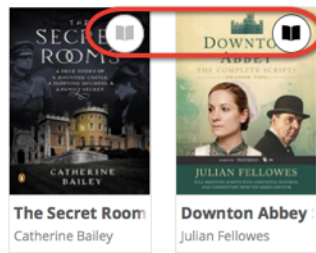
To sign in, please type your library's name and select it from the list.

- Berlin: Berlin Public Library
- Greenville: Chamberlin Free Public Library
- Groveton: Northumberland Public Library

Did you “lose” the navigation menu? Get it back by clicking here:

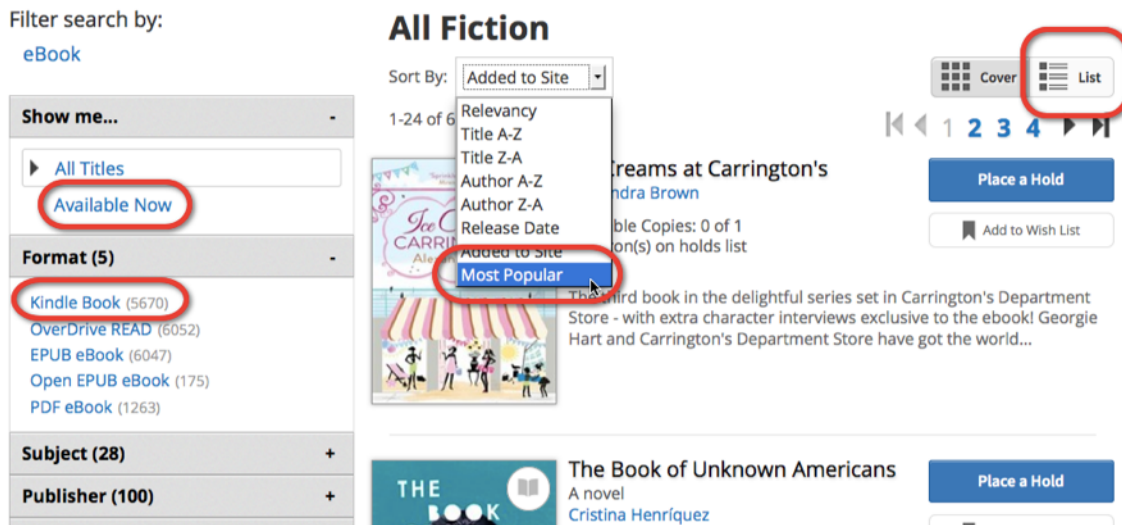


- From the menu, select “All Fiction” or “All Nonfiction” in the eBook columns.
- Click “Available Now” to narrow your results to eBook that you can check out right now.

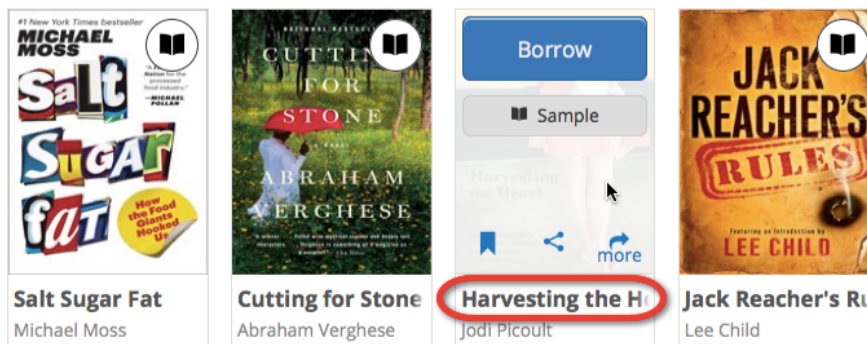


*Available titles show a black book icon in the corner of the book cover.*

- Open the “Formats” menu to select Kindle Books.
- You might also prefer to view the collection in “List” view. (List view shows more detail about each title without needing to click into the item record.)
- Sorting by “Most Popular” is a great way to see best sellers you might have missed.

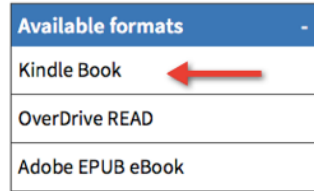


- When you find a title you’d like to check out, click on the title of the book.

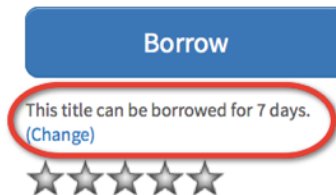


## Checkout the title

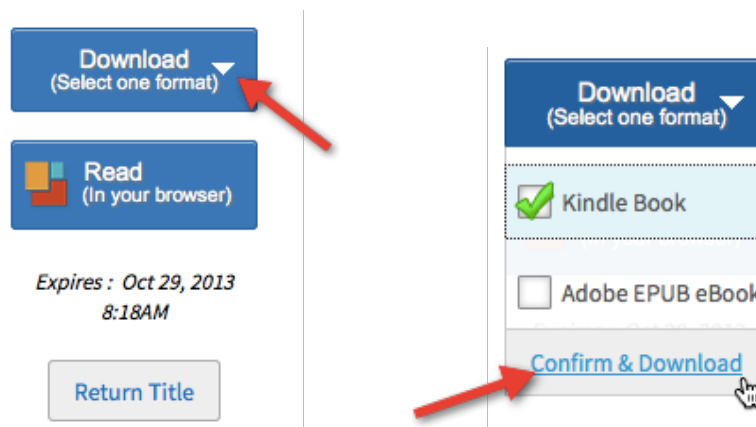
Double-check that the title is available in Kindle Book format, and click “Borrow” to check out the book.



*Note that you can change the default lending period **before** you borrow the book. You can choose between a default 7 or 14-day lending period.*



- You are brought to your account >> Bookshelf.
- Click “Download” and select the “Kindle Book” format.
- “Confirm & Download” to connect to Amazon’s Kindle Book page for this book.



*If you checked out the title by mistake, you can return it immediately from the bookshelf -- until you’ve selected a format. After that, you’ll have to return the book from the Amazon site >> Manage Your Content and Devices >> Actions >> Return Book.*

## At the Amazon site

A new browser window or tab opens and you are brought to your Kindle account. If you are already signed into Amazon, you'll be prompted to select a Kindle device or app to send the book to. If you are not signed in, click the "Get library book" to sign in and select a device or app.

*Tip: If you aren't already signed into Amazon, you might get a pop-up that encourages you to "Sign In." Do not click on that "Sign In" box. You'll be redirected from the correct path. Instead, be sure to click on "Get Library Book."*

## Wirelessly transferring the Kindle Book

Make sure your Kindle device or phone/tablet is connected to the internet. If the Kindle device offers 3G connectivity, be sure to connect to a local wireless network. Library loans cannot be transferred through Kindle's 3G network.

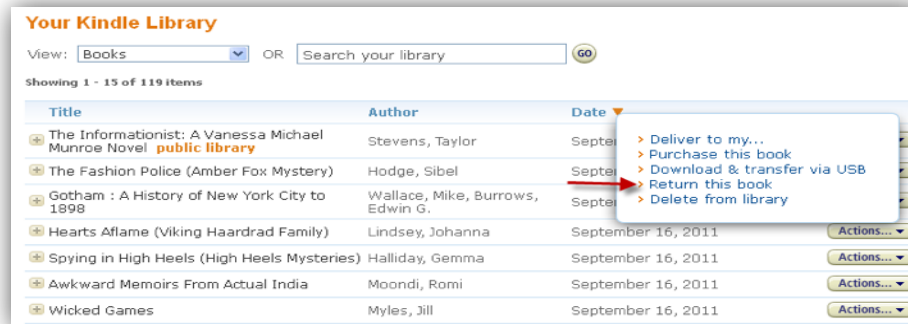
If the Kindle book does not show up on a Kindle app, sync the app. Pull downwards on the screen and release to sync. On a Kindle Fire, the "Sync" button is located under "Settings," a small cog-like button in the upper-right corner of the screen.

## Returning eBooks Early:

Returning the eBook back to the collection early allows you to check out more eBooks and others to get the book faster. It's a win-win!

Visit Amazon.com and see the "Your Amazon" link. Place your mouse over the link and select "Manage Your Content and Devices." You may get asked to verify your password before getting

into the account. Find the library eBook in your account, place your mouse over “Actions” and select “Return this book.”



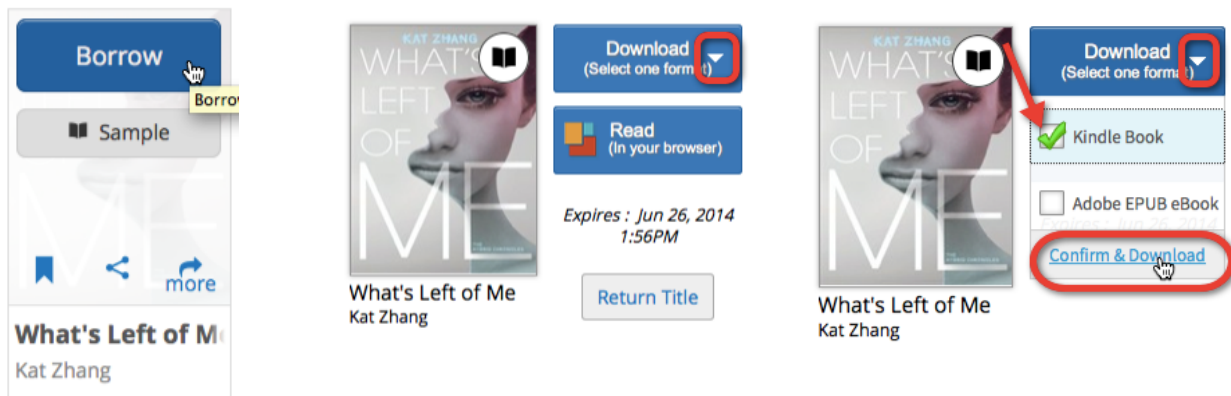
## USB Transfer

It is possible to transfer Kindle Books to Kindle devices with a USB cable and a computer. This is helpful if there is no available wi-fi or if the old model Kindle does not have wi-fi.

- Kindle device users can download the title to a computer and transfer the title to the “Downloads” folder on the Kindle.

After clicking “Borrow” you are brought to your account.

- Click on “Download (Select One Format).”
- Confirm & Download brings you to the book’s item record in Amazon’s Kindle site.



Tip: Remember to click “Get Library Book” and not the large “Sign In” button that pops up on the site when you aren’t already signed into Amazon.

Tip: Note the “Return Book” option for easy returns from this screen.

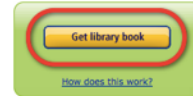

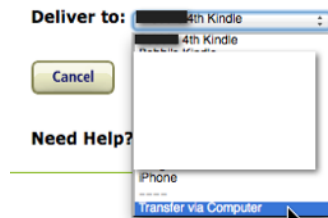

Select “Transfer via Computer.”

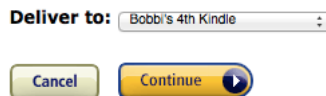

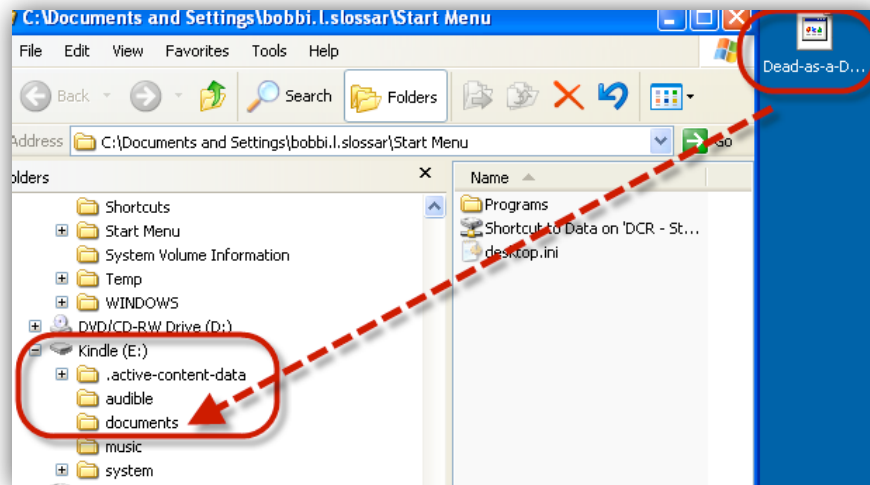
- Select the desired device associated with your account.

**please choose which Kindle you plan to transfer your title to via USB:**



- Download the file to the computer, noting where the file is saved.
- Tip: Saving the file to your computer’s desktop is always an easy way to find the file again!
- Locate the file.
- Plug in your Kindle.
- If using a Windows computer, wait for autoplay to appear.
- Open the folder to view files.
- Find the “Documents” folder.

- Select the file and Edit >> Copy and Edit >> Paste (or drag and drop) the .azw file into the Documents folder of the Kindle.



- Safely eject the Kindle.
- The book is ready to read in the Kindle.

Mac users should download the file to a known location, connect the Kindle, and use the “Finder” program to view the Kindle’s Document folder. Copy and paste (or drag and drop) the file to the “Documents” folder on the Kindle device. Safely eject the Kindle before disconnecting the cable.
